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1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

Birgunj Nursing Campus (BNC) is one of the constituent campuses of Tribhuvan University, Institute of Medicine, located in Madesh Province, Birgunj Metropolitan City, Birta - 4. Birgunj Nursing Campus was established in 2032 BS (1975 AD) with the Certified Medical Assistant (CMA) program named as Bara Parsa Programme. Proficiency Certificate Level (PCL) Nursing started in 2043 B.S (1986 AD). In 2068, B.S. Bachelor in Nursing (BN) Programme (Hospital Nursing) was started with 20 seats. Since the 2072 BS, two years BN program was substituted with 3 years Bachelor in Nursing Science (BNS) program, Generic Bachelor in Science (BSc). Nursing program has been started with 20 seats since 2077/078. In 2077 B.S PCL Nursing program was phased out from BNC. At present, the BNS and BScN. programs have been upgraded to 40 seats. To maintain the quality of nursing education, different committees such as IQAAC, Research and Publication Committee, Academic cell, Public Information Cell, EMIS Committee, Student Quality Circle etc. has been formed by the campus.

The goal is to achieve academic excellence; produce competent nursing health workforce, and enhance sustainable economic development.



5. INFRASTRUCTURE

5.1 Physical Facilities

BNC has a quiet atmosphere facility, a sound teaching-learning environment for the faculties and students to release their potential. It has a classroom with a multimedia projector to facilitate teaching-learning activities, and a well-equipped skilled lab also helps in teaching Nursing and Midwifery skills before posting the students in the clinical area. Each classroom has multimedia Projectors are fixed in each classroom and Fundamental Skill lab. There is a computer lab with an internet facility for students. There are two vehicles for transportation, and there are also hostel facilities for BSc.N and BNS students. Free wifi and continuous power supply are available on the campus.

5.2 Library

BNC has a separate library room, which contains more than 6,000 text books & reference books. The campus has used a barcode reader system in the library. The library is one of the most important parts of an institution. To be competent and to meet the growing needs of advancement in the learning area, the campus aims to establish a building with sufficient textbooks, reference books, periodicals, journals, magazines, newspapers, encyclopedias, e-libraries, and so on. The library's main aim is to provide resources and research support for students and faculty of an educational institution.

5.3 Computer lab

The students are provided with classes regarding computer courses. Students utilize the computer lab during their research projects too.

There are eight computers set up in computer lab for students. Mainly students use computer lab for their case study, report writing, presentation preparation and research purpose.

5.4 Clinical field facilities

BNC has access to general and specialized hospitals and community health services facilities within and outside the city for student clinical experience. The Narayani hospital is the major hospital where students of all programs receive hospital nursing experience. For the specialized area BNS and B.Sc.N students are exposed to BPKMCH, Chitwan for hospice and palliative care, National Medical Collage and Teaching Hospital, Birgunj for ICU, CCU posting TUTH for Psychiatric posting, Mahabir Prasad Kedia Eye Hospital for Eye posting, observation visit of different institutes like Hulas steel, water plants, Hetauda DDC, Blood Bank, Rehabilitation center, Geriatric home Hetauda , Birgunj and so on.

5.5 Cafeteria

BNC has a cafeteria that offers a wide choice of refreshments and foods. It is located at the southern premise of campus. Cafeteria has capacity of accommodating around 30-40 students at a time.

5.6 Hostel

There are three hostel buildings altogether there are 51 rooms for students, 3 students are accommodated in each room, 1 flat for the hostel warden, 1 room for the warden's office, 1 recreation room, 1 storeroom, 1 kitchen, and 1 dining hall. Dining hall is being used for multipurpose like workshop/training are held in dining hall.

The three years pass rate trend analysis shows that BNS and B.Sc Nursing program showed dissatisfying performance in all the academic years especially in 1st year. This might be due to the initiation of new subjects integrated basic health science I and II in both BNS and B.Sc program in first year which includes 6 different subjects.

8. PHYSICAL PROGRESS

8.1. Resource center (Library)

The Library is located within the academic building of the campus, which provides peaceful environment for study with a spacious well-furnished reading room. The old books have been replaced by new addition book in 2080 BS. There is high frequency internet facility to the readers since 2022 A.D. It provides open access to the students where students can easily view and read the books of their choice and issue if needed. At present, the library has books, national journals, international journals and research reports. The campus has two departmental libraries. There is Library Management Committee which organize meeting regarding library issues. There are two staffs recruited in library. The library is open from 8am to 8pm for all students, staffs.

In FY 2080/081 around text books and reference books were added costing Rs. 4,87,317 (Four lakh eighty seven thousand and three hundred seventeen only).

8.2. Photocopy Section

The photocopy section is available in library to facilitate to do photocopy of any material to faculty members and students of the campus.

8.3. Educational aids

Birgunj Nursing Campus has been giving more priority to modern technologies for better education system. The traditional uses of black board and chalk have already been replaced with white board and marker as well as projector. There are altogether 7 classrooms which are well furnished with the capacity of holding more than forty students. Each classroom is equipped with multimedia projector, white board, ceiling fan, wall fan, internet connection, ventilation with adequate light and comfortable furniture. Altogether there are 8 multimedia projectors. 6 printers in the campus which are currently in use.

Furthermore, the campus has 4 laboratories i.e. fundamental nursing lab, skill and maternity lab, basic science lab, nutrition and community lab. All the laboratories are well equipped and well furnished. Apart from this, power point presentation, group discussion, seminar, workshop, case study presentation, demonstration, re-demonstration and report writing have become a part of teaching learning activities of the campus.

9. RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

Research has a tremendous influence on current and future professional nursing practice, thus it is an essential component of educational process. Birgunj Nursing Campus has been engaging its faculty members and students in research activities. The campus has been supporting research activities within the campus. As per curriculum requirement students of BNS and BSc.Nsg have to conduct one research in an academic year. The campus and faculties provides supervision and guidance to

students in conducting research. Students have the opportunity to work with experienced faculty members and some of our faculty members have been awarded with research grants.

9.1 Research Management Cell

Research Management Cell (RMC) was established in 2077 BS to strengthen its capacity in faculty and student's research. The cell has been working towards developing quality research in nursing. It provides resources, training for conducting research activities.

RMC manages, maintains and records the research and research of all students and faculties of the campus. The campus often conducts various training with the initiation of RMC and financial support from campus from the faculty and students. In FY 2080/081 workshops on "Literature Review and Database Search", and "Proposal writing" and training on "Basic Life Support" funded by UGC has been conducted through the coordination of RMC. RMC of Birgunj Nursing Campus provides grants for mini research for faculties and certain seed money has been allocated for best two students in research from each program.

10. TRAINING PROGRAM

Birgunj Nursing Campus has conducted five training for faculties, staffs and students. Three days' workshop on "Literature Review and Database Search" from 2080, Poush 4-6, "Proposal Writing" 2080, Poush 13-15 "Humanity and Wellbeing in Nursing Profession" 2080, Chaitra 24-26 for students before their clinical placement and "Basic Life Support" was conducted by the financial support of University Grant Commission, Nepal on 2081, Jestha 5-7 and Non-credit course for 3 days on "Appreciative Inquiry" supported by Extended Performance Based Fund, BNC from 2081 Baisakh 14-16.

11. CURRICULAR AND EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

11.1 Student welfare and Student Quality Circle Activities

Student welfare committee is responsible for conducting various extracurricular activity. Student quality circle was also established by Birgunj Nursing Campus and different programs were organized by campus with co-ordination of student welfare committee and student quality circle.

11.2 Sports Meet

Birgunj Nursing Campus successfully celebrated its Sports Week Meet on 2080/09/16 to 2080/09/20 which was co-ordinated by student welfare committee and student quality circle. Campus chief inaugurated the Sports Meets 2080. Sports like Volleyball, Spoon marble race, Tug of war, Three legged race, balloon burst, Sack race, kho-kho, Ghaito Phutai, Badminton were organized by allocated teams with the participants of students and staffs. Prizes for winner was planned to be distributed on 48th Annual day programme of the Campus i.e Magh 18, 2080.

11.3 Orientation and Welcome Program of BNS/ B.Sc Students

On 10th Asadh 2080, formal welcome and orientation program was organized for the enrolled students of B.Sc Nursing 3rd batch and Bachelor of Nursing Science (BNS) 11th batch along with their guardians on chairmanship of campus chief of Birgunj Nursing Campus. 
