Internship Details

- Duration: 3 Months
- Internship Type: Project-based, academic/technical internship
- Work Areas:
 - Software design and development
 - Frontend and backend development
 - Database design and management
 - System testing and documentation

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be third-year BCT/BEI students of IOE constituent campuses
- Must have basic knowledge of software development concepts
- Ability to work in a team-oriented and professional environment

Preferred Skills (Not Mandatory)

- Frontend: HTML, CSS, JavaScript, React or similar frameworks
- Backend: PHP / Python / Java / Node.js
- Database: MySQL / PostgreSQL
- Basic understanding of APIs, version control (Git), and software lifecycle

Application Requirements

Interested students must submit the following through the Google Form:

- Updated Curriculum Vitae (CV)
 - Motivation Letter (brief statement explaining interest, relevant skills, and learning goals)
 - Academic details, relevant technical skills and all the details as requested in the form

Selection Process

- Submission of application does not guarantee selection
- Candidates will be shortlisted based on academic background, skills, and motivation
- Shortlisted candidates may be required to attend an interview or technical assessment
- Final selection will be based on overall merit and project requirements

- Selected interns are expected to maintain professional conduct, meet project timelines, and actively participate throughout the internship period.
- Upon successful completion, interns may be provided with an internship completion certificate and stipends as per institutional guidelines.
