### **Students Feedback Analysis Report**

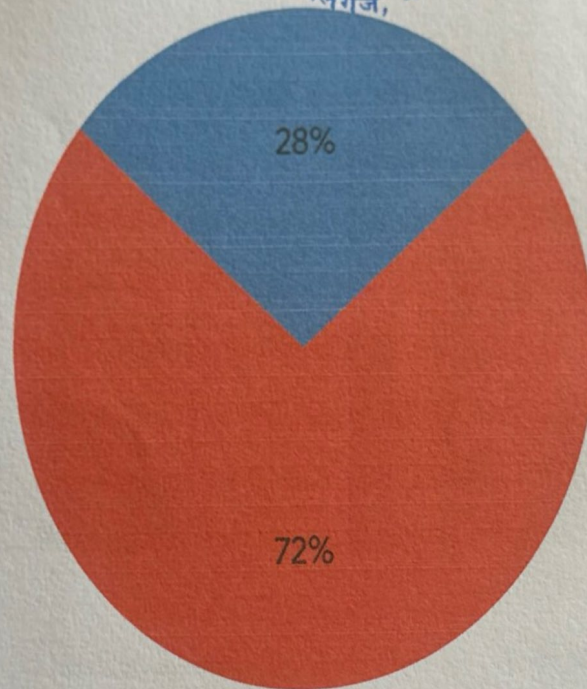
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This report details the findings from a student feedback survey conducted at Nepalgunj Nursing Campus. A total of 76 responses were collected, evaluating the academic curriculum, clinical practicals, and overall program satisfaction. The data highlights significant strengths in clinical exposure and a generally positive outlook on program recommendation.

#### **Student Profile**

The respondent pool represents two major nursing programs. The majority of participants are enrolled in the BSC Nursing program, while a smaller segment represents the BNS program.

Figure 1: Distribution of respondents by academic program. BSC Nursing students account for 72% of the total 75 recorded program responses, while BNS students comprise the remaining 28%.

### **Curriculum Evaluation (Theory Component)**

The theory component was assessed using a 5-point Likert scale ranging from "Strongly Disagree" (1) to "Strongly Agree" (5).

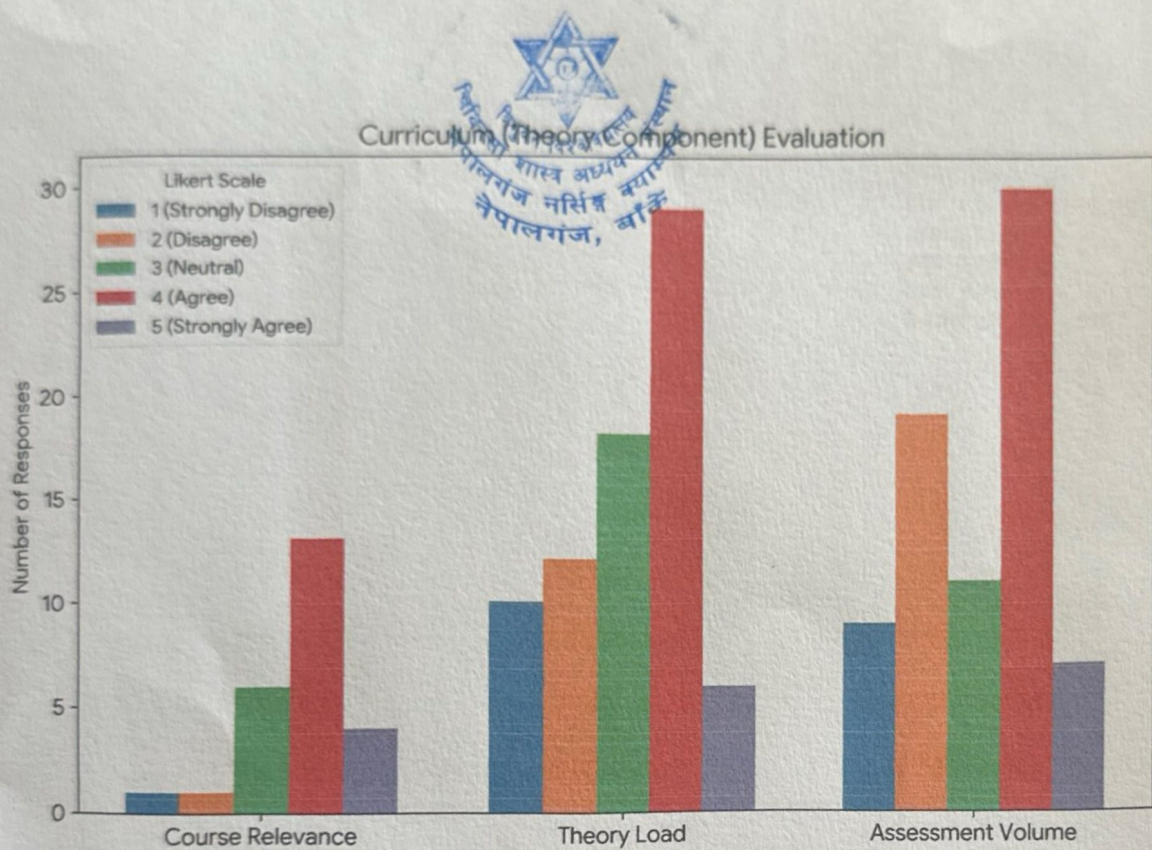


Figure 2: Student agreement ratings for the theoretical curriculum. Data shows a concentration of responses in the "Agree" (4) category across relevance and assessment volume, though a notable portion remains "Neutral" regarding theory load.

### Practical and Clinical Component

Clinical practicals are a cornerstone of the nursing program. Students rated their agreement with statements regarding exposure, supervision, and core skill opportunities.



### Practical & Clinical Component Evaluation

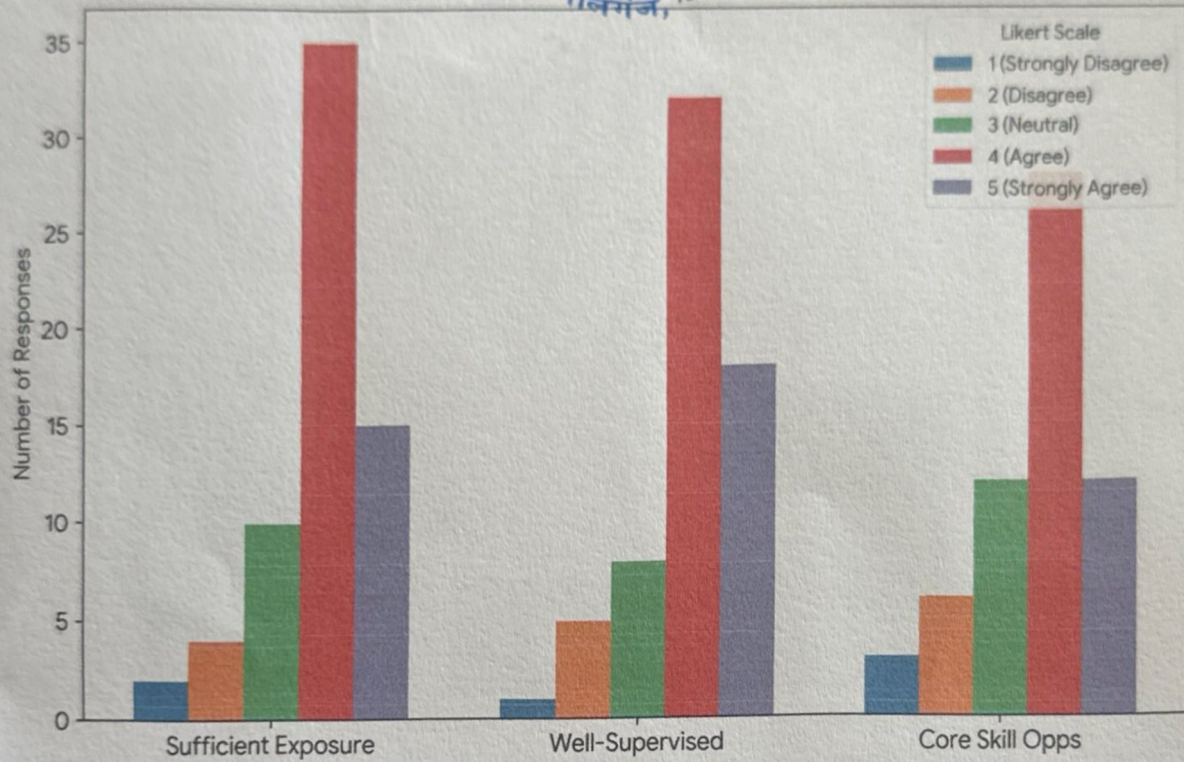


Figure 3: Evaluation of practical components on a 1-5 Likert scale. Results indicate high satisfaction with clinical exposure and supervision, with the majority of students selecting "Agree" (4).

### Overall Satisfaction and Recommendation

When asked if they would recommend the program to prospective students, the response was predominantly positive.

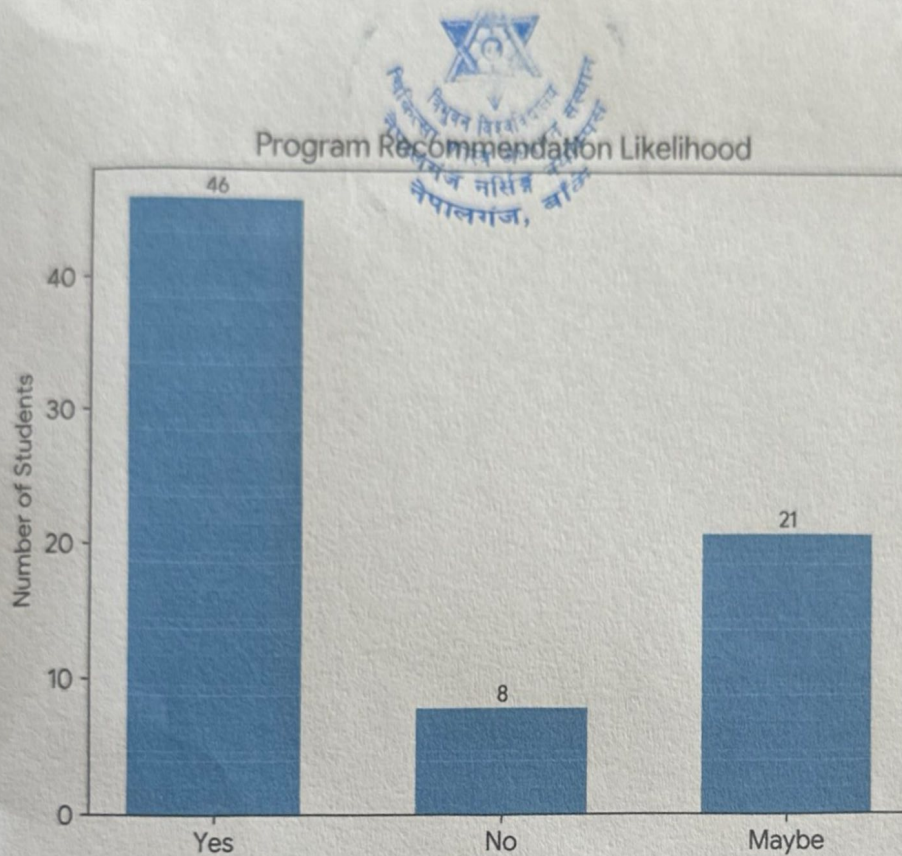


Figure 4: Frequency distribution of program recommendations. Over 60% of respondents explicitly stated "Yes," while a significant portion expressed uncertainty ("Maybe").
