

## Author Guidelines

### (I) Title

Title of the article should be smart, brief, and representative. The maximum length should be around 12 words. It should be written in title case (the first letter of each word except for functional word up to three letters should be capitalized). In the case of Nepali language, upper case and lower case are not applicable.

### (II) Abstract

Body of the manuscript should be preceded by an abstract with the maximum length of 150 - 200 words. It should be clear, concise, and complete in its own limits providing a brief summary of the research including the objective, methods, results and major conclusions. Do not include literature citations in the abstract. Besides, five to seven key words should be provided at the bottom of the abstract.

### (III) Main text

Main text should be organized under the following headings (IMReD):

**Introduction** should begin with a paragraph that introduces the title and describes the problem under investigation (e.g., existing knowledge and gap) leading to the main research questions and objectives.

**Methods** section should provide a clear description of the technical procedures which should include study design, area, population/participants, sampling, and data analysis.

**Results/Findings** should generally be stated concisely and clearly in descriptive, tabular, and graphical forms with interpretation and evidences.

**Discussion** should provide a) interpretation of the results, b) linkage/comparison of the results with previous research findings or theories, and c) implication of the results on the existing knowledge of the subject. It may include limitations, if any. Results/Findings and discussion could be merged under a single section.

**Conclusion** should critically reflect the knowledge from the main findings, and should highlight major contribution to knowledge generation.

### (IV) Acknowledgements

Acknowledgements should be short and specific providing information about various supports (e.g., funding, supervision, field assistance) received for the research.



#### **(V) References**

For the in-text citation and list of the references, APA 7th Edition should be followed.

#### **(VI) Appendix**

Appendix can be added if needed (within the page limit).

#### **(VII) Order details**

*Cover page* - The cover page must contain information about the title of the paper, authors' full name and address. All authors should appear with their full names, qualification and designation, affiliation, mobile numbers and e-mail addresses. One author should be identified as the corresponding author. Any information about the author should not be mentioned in the pages other than cover page.

*Spaces, margins, fonts and length* - Manuscripts should be in Times New Roman 12 pt and Preeti 16 pt characters, typed double-spaced with 1.5 cm margins in all sides of the A4 paper. The length of the manuscripts should be 4000-6000 words. Technical terms, mathematical symbols, abbreviations and acronyms used should be defined where they first appear in the text, equations, figures, or tables.

*Ethical review* - The authors should check the plagiarism for prepared articles before they submit the articles to the Dean's Office. For the Plagiarism check, authors should use ITHENTICATE software for the similarity index.

#### **PEER REVIEW PROCESS**

The Editorial Board will screen the manuscripts through desk review based on the guidelines for preparing research articles provided to the authors. The articles that fulfill the requirement of the guidelines will be selected and sent to reviewers. Based on the double-anonymized peer review principle, the article is sent to two reviewers. The reviewers are given two weeks period for reviewing the article based on review the guidelines given to them. Double anonymized peer review is applied for the article submitted by the author within the country. Reviewed papers are sent to the authors to incorporate the comments and suggestions given by both reviewers. Once the author submits the corrected paper addressing the reviewers' comments, it will be sent to the corresponding reviewers again to decide whether the manuscript has potential for acceptance. Authors should incorporate all questions or should defend (clarify) reviewers' comments. However, the final decision to accept paper for publication is taken by the editorial board.
