

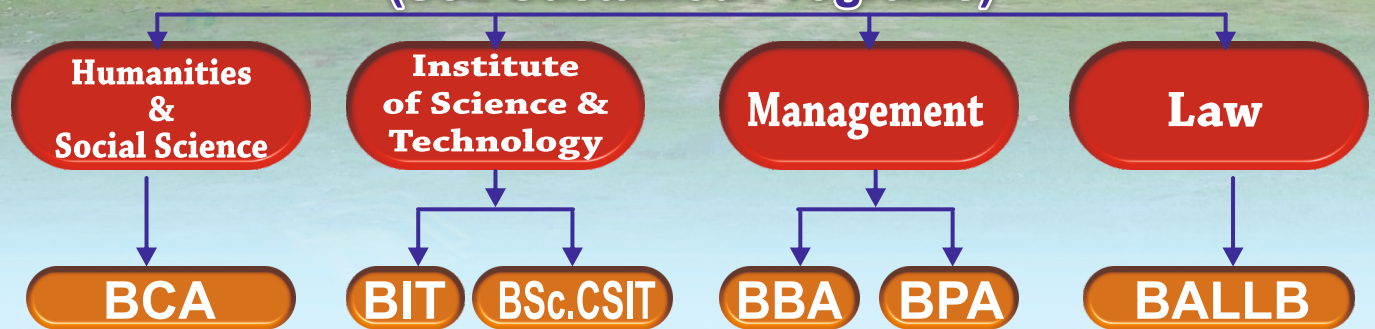

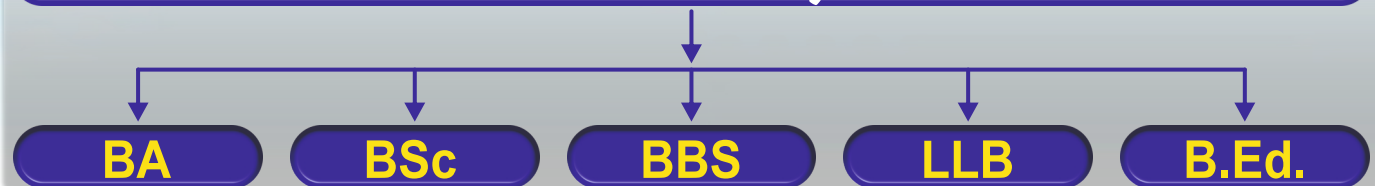

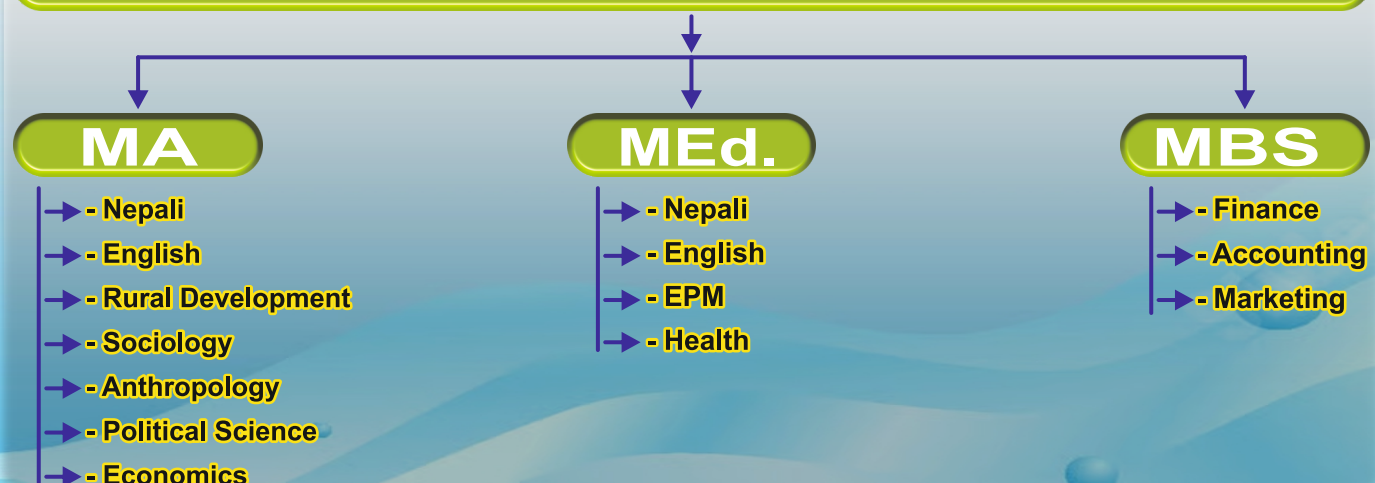

The Campus offers different courses under the multiple faculties of Humanities and Social Sciences, Management, Education, Law, Science and Technology.

## Our Courses

### Bachelor in Computer Applications (BCA)

Bachelor in Computer Applications (BCA), offered by the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, Tribhuvan University (TU) is the newly introduced subject approved from the academic year of 2071/72 B.S. This four years (8 semester) course has been started with an objective to produce qualified Computer software developers having wide range of knowledge in the technical field. Students admitted to this subject gets practical learning to solve computer based problems of different areas. At this time, the country requires scientists, social engineers, software developers for which this subject is the best one for the young aspirants to make their base and to contribute with the digital knowledge and skills.

#### Objectives of the BCA Program

- ◆ to produce professionals in the field of computer application as programmer and software developers,
- ◆ to provide knowledge about various tools and techniques used in software development,
- ◆ to provide students with both practical and theoretical aspects of studies related to computer applications,
- ◆ to enhance the skill of students to create solutions of technical problems that arises in industrial, commercial as well as in government companies,
- ◆ to provide students a fine base to continue their studies further such as Master in Computer Application (MCA), Masters in Arts as well as Management subject like MIT, MBA-IT, MBA and many more.

### Bachelors in Information Technology (BIT)

Bachelors in Information Technology (BIT) curriculum is designed by closely following the courses practiced in accredited international universities, subject to the condition that the intake students are twelve years of schooling in any stream or equivalent from any recognized board. In addition to the foundation and core Information Technology courses, the program offers several elective courses to meet the undergraduate academic program requirement and to fulfill the demand for development and implementation of new technology.

The main objective of BIT program is to provide students intensive knowledge and skill to design, develop, and use information technology in different areas. It is envisaged that graduate of this program will be equipped with necessary knowledge of Information Technology to compete in this global world.

### Bachelor of Science in Computer Science and Information Technology (B.Sc. CSIT)

The Bachelor of Science in Computer Science and Information Technology (B.Sc. CSIT) curriculum is designed by closely following the courses practiced in accredited international universities, subject to the condition that the intake students are twelve years of schooling in the science stream or equivalent from any university recognized by Tribhuvan University (TU). Students enrolled in the four year B.Sc. CSIT program are

required to take courses in design and implementation of computer software systems, foundation in the theoretical model of computer science, and a functional background of computer hardware. All undergraduate students are required to complete 126 credit hours of computer science course and allied courses.

The main objective of B.Sc. CSIT program is to provide students intensive knowledge and skill on different areas of computer science and information technology including design, theory, programming and application of computer system. It is envisaged that graduate of this program will be equipped with necessary knowledge of computer software and hardware system.

### **Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA)**

The Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) aims at educating students and preparing them for handling managerial positions to start a professional career in business or public management. It will enable them to take over responsible positions in domestic and global business organizations with modern impersonal skills and technical knowledge of the recent trends in global business. It is designed to provide students with a better and broader perspective of the world, society, business, and life by combining the study of social sciences and humanities with the study of business and management. The curriculum is built on four targeted learning competencies for starting a career in management and pursuing advanced management knowledge. This BBA program will develop positive attitudes, abilities, and practical skills that are needed for a competent and responsible manager, and the program will work as a foundation for master's studies in management.

#### **Objectives of BBA program**

Prepare students to take up middle-level managerial positions in the business sector.

Develop students' skills in business management of understanding and solving practical business problems creatively.

Provide professional management education with a blend of computer and management information system courses.

Prepare students to proceed onto postgraduate level study in business administration.

### **Bachelor of Public Administration (BPA)**

Bachelor of Public Administration (BPA) provides a comprehensive understanding of bureaucracy and the functioning of policy the national level. It is particularly advantageous for individuals aspiring to excel in the loksewa (public service) examination, as the course content aligns with the requirements of government jobs. Graduates of BPA have a higher likelihood of success in government job examinations due to the relevance of the course material and the questions asked in both BPA and public service exams. Upon the completion of BPA, individuals can further their studies by pursuing a Master's degree, as there is a direct linkage between BPA and MPA (Master of Public Administration). Additionally, Bachelor of Public Administration graduates can explore career opportunities in teaching and work with NGOS and INGOS, leveraging their knowledge and skills in public administration.

### **Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Law (BALLB)**

Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Law (BALLB) is a five years integrated under graduate degree that combines foundational liberal arts subject with comprehensive professional Law training. This course qualifies graduates to register with local bar council practice, advocate, legal advisor, cooperates lawyers or public prosecutors. +2 pass student from any stream are eligible to appear in university entrance and passed students are qualified to have admission in BALLB program.
