I would like to request all the interested teachers, staff and scholars of Psychology Department as well as other academic institutions/PhD scholars and independent researchers to submit their research articles until September 30, 2026.

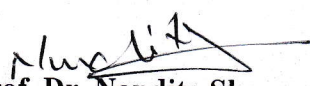
Psychological Studies Journal is a double-blind peer-reviewed multidisciplinary journal and is planned to publish two issues annually and is going to join Nepal Journals Online (NepJOL). The articles must be original and should follow the guidelines of research articles prepared by Research Directorates, TU.

All the submitted articles are first scanned and checked plagiarism and AI by RMC and the Editorial Board. Only short-listed articles are sent to reviewers. The manuscript should clearly describe the methods and research procedures used, present a description of the evidence, data and relevant facts, and scientific procedures, and coherently discuss arguments and results. The paper must be embedded in the psychological issues discussed and be presented in a structured and comprehensible manner. Authors should address comments/suggestions received from the reviewers within the article and present the list of the changes made on a separate sheet in the matrix form.

The manuscript should contain an abstract, introduction, methods, data materials, result and discussion and conclusion, and if necessary, acknowledgements and a list of references, (the manuscript body should have no information about the authors), Equations, figures, and tables must be referred into the text in numerical order. Footnotes and endnotes are not entertained. The length of the manuscripts should not exceed twenty pages, including figures and tables (4000-6000 words).

The number of figures and tables must not exceed seven on a single paper. Large tables and long lists should be presented as appendices. All contributors must assume full responsibility for the contents and opinions expressed in their writings. TU has a zero-tolerance policy on plagiarism. Entries of the references should be in alphabetical and chronological order of authors (DOI preferred) following APA 7th edition.

The Editorial Board reserves the right to edit, moderate or reject the articles without any condition. Manuscript should be sent as a MS word file to the following email address of the department:
