

Postgraduate Diploma in Education Entrance Test (PDEET) Framework

PDEET aims to assess the competency of the applicants who are pursuing Postgraduate Diploma (PGD) in Education in various specialized subjects. The test ensures that the applicants who secure a 40% cutoff score in the test have minimum entry competencies to study the PGD in Education. PDEET includes 100 multiple choice items. The applicants are provided with two hours to answer these items.

The competency framework of PDEET includes the following dimensions:



Weightage and Full marks

Areas	Weightage	No. of question & Full marks
School education, curricula, pedagogy, and assessment	30%	30
Language proficiency (Nepali & English)	30%	30
Research and statistics	20%	20
Information and communication technology	20%	20
Total	100%	100

Difficulty level of items: 30% very easy ($p > 0.8$), 30% easy ($p = 0.6 - 0.8$), 30% moderately difficult ($p = 0.4 - 0.6$), 10% difficult (< 0.4). **Cutoff point: 40%**



Domain I. School education, curriculum, pedagogy and assessment (30 questions)

This domain assesses applicants' knowledge on general educational system in Nepal, focusing particularly on school education in Nepal. The general area of this domain includes the structure of schooling, and curricular, pedagogical and assessment policies and provisions in school education in Nepal.

Examples:

What is the existing structure of basic education in Nepal?

- a. 1-5 b. 1-8 c. 1-10 d. 1-12

Which is the responsible body for developing and approving school textbooks in Nepal?

- a. Center for Education and Human Resource Development
b. Curriculum Development Center
c. Non-formal Education Center
d. Education Review Office

What is a primary characteristic of student-centered teaching?

- a. Emphasizing lecture-based instruction
b. Focusing solely on teacher's expertise and knowledge
c. Placing the student at the center of the learning process
d. Using standardized teaching materials without adaptations

What is the primary purpose of formative assessment in a classroom setting?

- a. Assigning grades to students' performance
b. Providing feedback to improve learning during instruction
c. Summarizing overall learning at the end of a course
d. Ranking students based on their academic performance

Domain II. Language Proficiency (30 questions)

Nepali – 15

English – 15

The domain assesses the basic competencies required for language proficiency and communication skills. It entails basic knowledge of words and grammar, paraphrasing, academic writing style (APA/MLA) required to structure the texts.

Examples:

What is the purpose of an abstract in an academic paper?

- a. To provide a summary of the author's personal opinions
- b. To present the methodology used in the research.
- c. To briefly summarize the main points and findings of the paper
- d. To include citations and references

Domain III. Research and statistics (20 questions)

This domain assesses the applicants' knowledge on basic overview of research and statistical applications of educational measurement and research.

Examples:

Which of the following best describes the primary goal of action research?

- a. To conduct experiments in controlled laboratory settings
- b. To explore theoretical concepts without practical applications.
- c. To bring about practical improvements or changes in a specific real-world context.
- d. To validate existing research theories without any modifications.

Which statistical method is commonly used in educational research to measure the strength and direction of relationships between two variables?

- a. Mean
- b. Median
- c. Correlation
- d. Regression

Domain IV. Information and communication technology (20 questions)

This domain assesses students' knowledge and skills on using ICT in various areas of education. As the basic ICT skills are crucial for graduate students, this domain assess the prerequisite ICT knowledge required for communication, preparing written documents, presentation and data analysis.

Examples

Which of the following software applications is commonly used for creating and editing text documents?

- a. Microsoft Excel
- b. Adobe Photoshop
- c. Microsoft Word
- d. Google Chrome

What is the primary function of a spreadsheet software like Microsoft Excel in educational and research settings?

- a. Creating and editing images
- b. Analyzing data and performing calculations
- c. Sending and receiving emails
- d. Creating presentations
