The Research Committee of the Institute of Forestry (IOF), Pokhara Campus invites a call for research proposals from faculty teams at IOF-Pokhara. This research grant aims to foster and reinforce innovative research concepts, as well as the initiation and continuation of extensive, long-term monitoring studies. Interested applicants must submit their research proposals in the provided format, focusing on designated thematic areas. Submission should be made through the campus administration within the specified deadline.

Proposal Format

I. Cover Page:

One page that includes research title, names, and contact details of applicants (email, phone), institution, requested amount, project start and end dates.

II. Narrative Section:

Abstract:

(Not exceeding seven pages excluding references)

Introduction:

A concise half-page summary with a maximum of 300 words. A maximum of one and half pages based on a review of relevant and recent literature supporting the contextual background, providing a clear statement of research gaps, and emphasizing the study's significance.

Rationale of the study:

Half page

Research Objectives:

Two to three specific objectives. Description highlighting the features of the study sites relevant to the proposed research.

Study Area:

Two to three pages offering a clear description of the research design, data collection methods and tools, and statistical analysis.

Methodology:

Six Months

Timeframe:

Maximum NRs. 180000 (One lakh eighty thousand)

Budget plan:

APA format

References:

MS Word format, Font: Times New Roman, Font size: 12, Line spacing: 1.5 points, Page margins: one inch (1") on all four sides.


