Required documents:

1. Application Form (Available at RMC office/website).
2. Research Proposal (APA Format, Max. 10-15 Pages)
 - Title Page: Research title, name, department, contact details.
 - Introduction: Background, problem statement, research questions.
 - Objectives: Clear and measurable research goals.
 - Literature Review: Summary of existing research.
 - Methodology: Research design, sample size, data collection tools.
 - Ethical Considerations (if involving human subjects).
 - Expected Outcomes & Significance.
 - Work Plan and Budget Details.
 - References (APA 7th Edition).
3. Academic Credentials (Copy of highest degree certificate).

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

1. Who Can Apply?

- Full-time faculty members of Nepalgunj Nursing Campus.
- One faculty proposal from each department (Adult Health Nursing, Midwifery, Pediatric Nursing, Community Health Nursing, Psychiatric Nursing).

2. Who Cannot Apply?

- Faculty who have received an RMC grant in the previous year.
- Faculty with pending incomplete research projects from past grants.
- Proposals that do not follow ethical guidelines (e.g., plagiarism).
