# CEDECON's Annual International Conference in Economics (CAICE 2025)

*(Macroeconomic Stability, Good Governance, and Sustainable Development)*

18-19 SEPTEMBER, 2025 | KATHMANDU, NEPAL

The submission of full papers for CAICE-2025 is now open. Submissions are encouraged on, but not limited to, the following broad themes.

- **Money, Macroeconomics, and Finance:** This theme covers Monetary policy, financial markets, exchange rates, fiscal policy, banking systems, financial crises, economic growth models, savings and investments, financial development, and other closely related areas of study.
- **Public Policy and Good Governance:** This theme spans Policy Formulation and Implementation, Local Governance Efficiency, Public Procurement and Capital Expenditure, Transparency and Accountability, E-Governance and Digital Transformation, Public-Private Partnerships (PPPs), Social Equity and Inclusive Policies, Evidence-Based Policymaking, and closely related areas of study.
- **Economics of Sustainability:** This theme incorporates all the SDGs. The focuses will be Green Growth and Sustainable Development, Circular Economy and Resource Efficiency, Economics of Climate Change, Renewable Energy Economics, Agriculture and Food Security, Environmental Valuation and Natural Capital, Sustainable Urbanization and Infrastructure, Biodiversity Conservation, Behavioural Economics and Sustainability, Financing Sustainable Development, Foreign Employment and Remittance, Tourism and Gig-Economy.

### Important Dates:

- Deadline for Full Paper Submission: July 31, 2025
- Notification of Acceptance: August 15, 2025
- Submission of Revised Papers: August 25, 2025
- Registration Deadline: August 31, 2025

### **Registration Fee and Financial Support:**

The presenting author of an accepted paper (limited to one presenter per paper) is not required to pay a registration fee. A limited number of travel and accommodation grants will be provided for candidates in need. The financial need request must be submitted with a reason while submitting the full paper. Observers wishing to attend the conference will be charged a registration fee of NPR 2,000 for Nepali nationals, NPR 5000 for nationals from the South Asian region, and NPR 10,000 for others.

### **Paper Format and Structure:**

Submissions should adhere to the standard academic format for conference papers.

- The first page must include:
  - Title of the Paper
  - Name(s) of Author(s) and Co-author(s)
  - Abstract (maximum 200-300 words)
  - Keywords: Less than or equal to five
  - JEL Classification Codes: Less than five
- The main text of the paper should include appropriate headings and subheadings, where suggested sections include:
  - Introduction
  - Literature Review
  - Methodology
  - Results and Discussion
  - Conclusion and Policy Implications

Author(s) can follow the guidelines of the Economic Journal of Nepal (<https://cdec.tu.edu.np/pages/the-economic-journal-of-nepal-1189>) while preparing the paper. Author(s) must ensure that the paper has not been previously published and is not under review elsewhere.
