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1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 BACKGROUND

The school of nursing was first established in Kathmandu in 1956 under the directive of the health service, ministry of health. The first batch of this school had enrolled only 15 students. The expected proficiency of the produced manpower was illness oriented. Principally this was a Hospital oriented curriculum that was in effect between 1956 to 1986. This curriculum aimed at preparing nurses to be efficient in fulfilling the health needs of the people of Nepal. With the introduction of the new educational system in 1972, nursing education was brought under the Institute of medicine, Tribhuvan University. After that, a major revised curriculum that was based on primary health care was introduced in 1987 which was again updated in 2006. The aim of this programme was to prepare competent and self-reliant nurses who would be able to care for the individual, family and community.

Nepalgunj Nursing Campus is the only one constituent nursing campus of Tribhuvan University; Institute of Medicine in province no 5 Lumbini, Karnali and Sudurpaschim. The campus is located in Nepalgunj sub-metropolitan city (SMPC), ward no - 10, in close proximity with Bheri Hospital.

The Ministry of Health established ANM training school in 1969 in Nepalgunj. The school over a period of 17 years produced 406 ANMs. In 1987, it was upgraded to Proficiency Certificate Level (PCL) nursing campus. Since then it has produced 1063 staff nurses. Currently 90 students are pursuing education at various levels.

Sighting the need for middle level manpower in nursing, in 2011, 2 years Bachelor in Nursing (BN) programme was started which from 2013 was revised to as 3 years Bachelor of Nursing Science (BNS).

1.2 Vision

Advancing the nursing profession and changing lives through academic distinction, knowledge, innovation and continuous progress in application of qualitative globalized services to every sector of nursing that ensures quality health care for all people.


SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

3. AFFILIATION AND ACCREDITATION

Nepalgunj Nursing Campus is a constituent campus of TU, which is one of the oldest and largest university in Nepal. TU is ranked as 1001+ universities of the world and 351-400th of Asia as per “The World University Rankings 2020”.

In Nepal, Nepal Nursing Council (NNC) is a statutory body for establishing uniform and high standards of nursing education. However, as per the provision of National Medical Education Act 2075, recently Medical Education Commission has been established to develop medical education in line with the national needs and regulate medical education which also includes nursing education, in integrated and efficient way. Therefore, at present Medical Education Commission is the authorized regulatory body for providing accreditation to the Nursing program in Nepal. Nepalgunj Nursing Campus is also in the process of getting accreditation from Medical Education Commission of Nepal.

Similarly, University Grants Commission (UGC) has launched the Quality Assurance and Accreditation (QAA) program as an important aspect of reform in higher education in Nepal. The system ensures that the campus meets the certain predetermined minimal criteria or standards, not only at institutional level but also in its academic programs to offer better results to the society. Understanding its importance, Nepalgunj Nursing Campus has initiated the process of getting QAA from UGC and at present the campus is working on QAA process i.e. preparation of self-study report (SSR). It is hoped that the campus will achieve QAA certificate within the specified period of time.

The Post Basic Bachelor of Nursing (PBBN) program was initiated in 2069 BS with the duration of 2 years. The curriculum was further revised in 2070 BS and made it a 3 year program with provision of core courses in the first and second year and some major courses in the third year and named as Bachelor of Nursing Science program. 10. PHYSICAL PROGRESS

10.1 RESOURCE CENTER (LIBRARY)

The Library is located within the premises of the campus, which provides a wide range of congenial study environment with a spacious well-furnished reading room. There is high frequency internet facility to the readers. At present, the library holds 9277 books, 63 national journals, 114 Magazines , 232 reference books, 9045 text books. The library's digital collection has been in progress.

10.2 EDUCATIONAL AIDS

Nepalgunj Nursing Campus has been trying to update the teaching learning materials and pedagogy in accordance with the change in information technology and teaching trend in contemporary society. The campus gives more priority to modern technologies for better education system. The traditional uses of black board and chalk have already been replaced with white board and marker. There are altogether 6 classrooms which are well furnished with the capacity of holding more than forty students. Each classroom is equipped with multimedia projector, white board, ceiling fan, ventilation with adequate light and comfortable furniture. Altogether there are 7 multimedia projectors, 25 computers, 7 laptops and 6 printers in the campus which are currently in use. Furthermore, the campus has 4 laboratories i.e. fundamental nursing lab, skill and maternity lab, basic science lab, nutrition and community lab. All the laboratories are well equipped and well furnished. The campus has adopted all mechanism to make teaching and learning more effective and practical. It has implied modern technologies, modern teaching materials, and student centered teaching methods. Power point presentation, group discussion, seminar, workshop, case study presentation, demonstration, re-demonstration and report writing have become a part of teaching learning activities. Apart from these, students are also encouraged for self-directed learning. Moreover, clinical skills are being practically taught through posting students in various practical areas as per the curricular requirement.

10.3 PHYSICAL FACILITIES AND INFRASTRUCTURE

The nursing campus of TU IOM is a leading institution in the region, serving the provinces of Lumbini, Karnali, and Sudurpaschim. The campus covers 1 bigha 16 kattha 14 dhur (within campus premises). It boasts a team of highly qualified and dedicated faculties, administrative staff, and supportive staff, creating a peaceful learning environment. The campus is equipped with skills labs, a computer lab, library, and classrooms. Transportation facilities, including 1 mini bus and 1 Tata Sumo Gold, are available for students' convenience. Hostel facilities, generator backup and free Wi-Fi are provided to ensure a comfortable and conducive learning experience.

The campus comprises 10 buildings, including an administrative building with various sections, faculty rooms, and a library. There are also 2 academic buildings, 2 hostel blocks, and a skills lab building with separate rooms for nursing fundamentals, community health, midwifery, and basic science. The campus provides sample clinical areas for practical training and exposure in specialized hospitals. Additionally, there are staff residence building including 1 for the campus chief and 2 for academic and administrative staff is available. A canteen is also available to cater to the dietary needs of students and staff.

11. QAA/EMIS

The goal of Quality Assurance and Accreditation (QAA) is to raise the standard of education in Nepal. The QAA system makes sure that a higher education institution has met a set of requirements, both at the institutional level and in their academic programs, in order to provide better results to society.

Nepalgunj Nursing Campus is in the process of attaining QAA issued by the University Grants Commission; Nepal. It is qualified for the QAA project because it has the LOI acceptance letter from the UGC dated March 14, 2022. Under the leadership of campus chief Tulasa Sunar, the campus has established an Internal Quality Assurance Committee (IQAC), Education Management and Information System (EMIS), and Self-Assessment Team (SAT). It is expected that the Nepalgunj Nursing Campus will complete QAA cycle within five years.

The following three committees are working on the QAA system of this institution:

1. Internal Quality Assurance Committee (IQAC): This committee is the governing body of the QAA process of Nepalgunj Nursing Campus, which makes policy to work on the process and monitor the progress of the QAA process. To accomplish various tasks required for QAA process, different committees have been formed to support IQAC.

2. Self-Assessment Team (SAT): This team prepares a self-study report to submit to the QAA Division of UGC for the certificate of accreditation.

3. Education Management and Information System (EMIS): The EMIS of the campus has been working to publish notices, advertisements, annual progress reports, audit reports etc. in webpage for public information and transparency. This team prepares a data system of higher education institution called Education Management Information System (EMIS) and publishes a booklet. This includes a framework of indicators, tools and modality for annual data collection, regular data updating, analysis and reporting.

12. RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

Research is a crucial part of the training process since it has a significant impact on both present and future professional nursing practice. The Nepalgunj Nursing Campus has developed over the past few years into a significant research institution, including both its staff and students in research activities. The campus is committed to support research activities within the campus. Both faculty members and students at the campus are encouraged to take advantage of a wide range of research opportunities. As per the curricular requirement, students of Bachelor of Science in Nursing, Bachelor of Nursing Sciences and have to conduct one research in an academic year. The campus provides support to the students engaged in research and faculties supervise students to conduct research and write reports. The students have the opportunity to work alongside experienced faculty members in a variety of settings. Furthermore, under these research activities, some of our faculty members have been awarded research grants from TU IOM mini research grant, NHRC, UGC. All the faculties of Nepalgunj Nursing Campus have published articles in national and international journals.

12.1 RESEARCH MANAGEMENT CELL

The goal of the campus' Research Management Cell (RMC) is to advance and improve the standard of multidisciplinary research activities. To carry out the research activities across a number of academic areas,

the Research Management Cell was established. Novel perspectives in knowledge will be identified, through the investigation and validation of creative ideas. In order to promote and strengthen the research area, the key activities to be offered by the RMC mainly are faculty development, faculty research grants management, organizing research workshops and training, providing research resources and facilities to faculties and students, publishing research articles, conducting mini-research report presentation and coordinating the overall research activities of the campus. The RMC carries out its operations as per the RMC guidelines formulated.

Nutritional exhibition provide knowledge of nutritious intake of food for healthy living, disease prevention and treatment. The main reason behind unhealthy food habits is the lack of knowledge so awareness about food habits is important. Hence “Nutrition Exhibition” was organized by students of BSc.
