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ABOUT US

Birgunj Nursing Campus (BNC) was established in 2032 BS, which is a constituent campus of Tribhuvan University, Institute of Medicine (T.U.I.O.M) with a mandate to work towards developing socially responsible and competent health workforce, providing health care and engaging in health research. The Institute is located in northern Nepal and it has extended its continued health services through teaching district concept to Primary Health Care Centers, District Hospitals and sub-regional Hospitals in three districts of the region. The campus is only TU constituent campus of nursing existing in Madhesh Pradesh. The Institute is located in eastern Nepal and it has extended its continued health services through teaching district concept to Primary Health Care Centers, District Hospitals and Zonal Hospitals in eight districts of the region.

During its 47 years of existence, Birgunj Nursing Campus has made a significant progress. It has been upgraded its academic program from Auxillary Health Worker (AHW) to undergraduate programmes of Nursing and is looking forward to bring further higher education. In 2038 BS, AHW training program upgraded to Proficiency Certificate level (PCL) for Health Assistant. PCL Nursing program was started in 2043 BS and has been phased out in 2077 BS. In 2068, Bachelor in nursing (BN) 2-year Programme with 20 students was started with hospital nursing as major subject and further Bachelor in Nursing Science (BNS) 3-years program was started with 20 students and now upgrade to 40 seats among which 25 seats are allotted for adult nursing, 10 for community nursing and 5 for peadiatric nursing as specialty subject. Similarly, the campus has also started B. Sc. Nursing programme from 2077 BS with 30 seats. At present TU IOM, Birgunj Nursing Campus, is running only under graduate programmes in nursing i.e. BNS and B. Sc. Nursing with 40 seats in each program.

Admission Requirement

Admission Criteria are clearly defined by Medical Education Commission (MEC).

1. Bachelor of Nursing in Science

To be eligible for selection to the BNS course, a candidate should have successfully completed 3 years Proficiency certificate level nursing from a recognized institution and should have secured an aggregate of 50% or more marks. Candidates should be physically and mentally fit.

The applicant must submit:

- A complete application form along with the photocopies
- Documents of certificated level in nursing (mark sheets, character certificate and degree).
- Nepal Nursing Council registration certificate.
- Citizenship
- Candidates will be selected on the basis of merit list and online counseling of the Common Entrance Examination conducted by Medical Education Commission (MEC).

2. B. Sc. Nursing program:

(The duration of B. Sc. Nursing course has been designed for four academic years)

To be eligible for selection to the BSN course, a candidate should have successfully completed intermediate science or 10+2 or A level with biology are eligible with equivalent to C+ or 50% in aggregate or minimum GPA 2.4 as per National Examination Board of Nepal. Candidate must be physically and mentally fit.

The applicant must submit:

- A complete application form along with the photocopies.
- Documents of intermediate science or 10 + 2 certificate (mark sheets, character certificate).
- Citizenship

Candidates will be selected on the basis of merit list and online counseling of the Common Entrance Examination conducted by MEC.

Fee Structure & Scholarship

75 % of the students receive merit scholarship in BNS and BSN programs. The campus collects fee from the student as per T.U. IOM policy. The campus also provides scholarship to the needy students who come from different backgrounds. Each year, campus administration notifies to all its students regarding the application procedure, requirement and deadline for the scholarships.

Co-curricular Activities

Extra Curricular Activities


Extra Curricular Activities helps to reduce stress, enhance the team spirit with overall physical and mental development. Under the students welfare committee, campus organizes sports week every year in order to explore the hidden talent and to give a break in the hectic schedule. It includes with wide range of indoor and outdoor games. Indoor activities includes Quiz competition, table tennis, Ludo and outdoor activities includes volleyball, football, kabaddi, badminton, tug of war, pot breaking, musical chair. Daily one hour yoga sessions is running inside the campus for the well-being enhancement of students and staff.

Students regularly participate in cultural program on different occasions such as welcome and farewell program, annual day and Nurses day celebration.



Education Management Information System (EMIS)

Birgunj Nursing Campus uses EMIS software for the digitalization of all data related campus activities. All the data in the system is highly secured in cloud applying the best security policy. All the academic information related to students, staffs and official information are recorded in the system. The system is also running in the various departments of the campus for storing data and information retrieval. The system also works for attendance measurements of every staffs. Moreover, campus has formed an EMIS committee and IT Department for proper management of information system.



Hostel /Quarter

Birgunj Nursing Campus has provided hostel facility to students, that consists of 6 blocks having 52 rooms with the capacity of accomodating 156 students. There is separate block for kitchen and dining hall. Warden quarter is available for warden who is responsible for overall activities of hostels. Security guard are assigned to ensure 24 hours security service.

There is a provision of residence/quarter for faculties and staffs with 6 blocks named 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6. Overall it consist of 15 sub-blocks. Each sub-block consists of 1 bedroom, 1 kitchen and a bathroom.

Library

Campus is providing library facility that consists of different text books, national and international reference books, journals, periodicals, national and local newspapers. It provides a wide range of congenial study environment for 100 readers with a spacious fully furnished reading room. At present, the library holds approximately 6000 text books, reference books and 100 national, international journals 80 and other books. Students have access central library e-resources for research related work.



Nursing Laboratories

Campus has four laboratories which includes fundamental of nursing skill lab, midwifery and Paediatric lab, Basic Science Lab, Community and Nutritional skill lab. All the laboratories are well furnished and well equipped.

Transportation

Campus has one jeep for official use and one bus to provide transportation service for different academics activities of students. Students are taken to different community field concurrent and residential leadership and management, observation visit and institutional visit to different organization and hospitals.



Infrastructure & Facilities



E-Library

Campus has E-Library with 8 desktop-computers along with internet service. The library digital collection continues to grow at a rapid pace as a E-resource centre. It provides online access to different databases such as HINARI, AGORA, GOALI, OARE and ARDI for faculty members, students and researchers. In addition, there is collection of research report of bachelor students.

Classroom

The classroom are well furnished and well equipped with the capacity of holding about 45 students. Each classroom is equipped with multimedia projector and green/white board. Additional infrastructures like ceiling fan, electrical port, inverter facility. Internet connection is available.

Playground

Campus has adequate unoccupied space which has been used for playground during sports activities. Games like volleyball, football, kabaddi, badminton, chess, Tug of War, pot breaking and musical chair are being played. A table tennis board is also present in the playground.

Internet

Birgunj Nursing Campus has total dedicated band with of 15 Mps. Campus is providing fully dedicated wired and wireless internet facility to all the faculty, staffs and students in administration, faculty room, departments, library, E-Library, hostel and residence.

Power Backup

For smooth and continuous functioning of campus activities, the campus has electric backup facility. There is 1 generator, solar lights & inverter in the campus.

Infrastructure & Facilities

First Aid

Campus has well equipped sick room in the ground floor of the academic block. The room is well equipped with a bed with pillows, bedside locker, foot step, medicine cupboard, vital sign tray, Intravenous stand, Intravenous fluids, dressing sets, sanitary pads, all other minimum requirements for the first aid treatment.



Meeting Hall/ Seminar Cum Conference Hall

This Seminar Cum Conference Hall is situated on 1st floor of administration building. It is well furnished and well equipped with multimedia projector, podium, sound system, internet. It has the capacity of holding around 40 participants. This hall is used for conducting various training, workshop, seminars, meeting in the campus.



Vehicle Parking

There is a garage facility inside the campus premises for faculties, staffs and students.



Cafeteria

Campus has cafeteria where fresh hygienic food and delicious are made as preferred by faculty, staff and students.

Academic Faculties

Birgunj Nursing Campus comprised of highly qualified and experienced faculty members with specification in different stream that includes Adult Health Nursing Department, Midwifery/Women Health and Development Department, Community Health Nursing Department, Psychiatric Nursing. All the faculties are very enthusiastic and have participated in different trainings, conferences, seminars, webinars and workshops. Also they eagerly carry out research and have published their work in different national and international journals. Faculty members take classes, supervise students in clinical and community practicum. Altogether there are 18 full time and 12 part time academic faculties in the campus

Administrative staff

Administrative staffs of Birgunj Nursing Campus includes staffs from administration, academic administration, examination section, finance section, library, store and office helpers. They perform the administrative responsibilities and are dedicated to support student's teaching learning, research and public services. Altogether there are 23 administrative staffs in the campus.



Research Management Cell

The campus has Research Management cell (RMC) which sees the research activities of students and faculties as well. The RMC funds faculty research and seed money grants for student research. It conducts some consultancy and extension activities as well.

Future Plan


