It is one of the constituent campuses under the **Institute of Medicine (IOM)**, Tribhuvan University. Over the past **56 years of academic excellence**, the campus has been committed to providing quality nursing education and has made a remarkable contribution to the development of the nursing profession in Nepal.

The campus currently runs various academic programs, including the **Bachelor in Nursing Science (BNS)** and **Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.Sc. Nursing)** programs. Following the decision of Tribhuvan University to phase out the intermediate level, the campus discontinued the intake of students in the **Proficiency Certificate Level (PCL) Nursing Program** from **2020 A.D.**

All academic activities of the campus are guided by its clearly defined **mission and vision**. In addition to academic excellence, the campus places strong emphasis on **co-curricular and extracurricular** activities for the holistic development of students. The graduation trend analysis reveals consistent and commendable academic performance of students over the years, and the current year continues this legacy of success.

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1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

The school of nursing was first established in Kathmandu in 1956 under the directive of the health service, ministry of health. The first batch of this school had enrolled only 15 students. The expected proficiency of the produced manpower was illness oriented. Principally this was a Hospital oriented curriculum that was in effect between 1956 to 1986. This curriculum aims to prepare nurses to be efficient in fulfilling the health needs of the people of Nepal. With the introduction of the new educational system in 1972, nursing education was brought under the Institute of Medicine, Tribhuvan University. After that, a major revised curriculum that was based on primary health care was introduced in 1987, which was again updated in 2008. The aim of this program was to prepare competent and self-reliant nurses who would be able to care for the individual, family and community. Nepalgunj Nursing campus is the only one constituent nursing campus of Tribhuvan University; Institute of medicine in Lumbini, Province. The campus is located in Nepalgunj sub-metropolitan city (SMPC), ward no - 10, in proximity with Bheri Hospital. The Ministry of Health established ANM training school in 1969 in Nepalgunj. The school over a period of 17 years produced 406 ANMs. In 1987, it was upgraded to Proficiency Certificate Level (PCL) nursing campus. Since then it has produced 1153 PCL. Seeing the need for middle level manpower in nursing, in 2011, 2 years Bachelor in Nursing (BN) programme was started which from 2013 was revised to as 3 years Bachelor in Nursing Science (BNS). The four year BSC nursing program was established in 2021 AD in this Campus, since then the total number of Bachelor graduated students is 192. Currently, 241 students are pursuing education at various levels.

1.2 Vision

To be a center of excellence in nursing education, research and service, producing competent, compassionate and globally competitive nursing professionals who contribute to improving health care and society.

1.3 Mission

To serve the people of Nepal by:

- Providing high-quality nursing education that intergrates theory, practice, and research.

- Promoting community health through outreach, service and collaboration.

1.5 Objectives



3. AFFILIATION AND ACCREDITATION

Nepalgunj Nursing Campus is a constituent campus of TU, which is one of the oldest and largest university in Nepal. Nepal Nursing Council (NNC) is a statutory body for establishing uniform and high standards of nursing education of Nepal. However, as per the provision of National Medical Education Act 2075, recently Medical Education Commission has been established to develop medical education in line with the national needs and regulate medical education which also includes nursing education, in integrated and efficient way. Therefore, at present Medical Education Commission is the authorized regulatory body for providing accreditation to the Nursing program in Nepal. Nepalgunj Nursing Campus is also in the process of getting accreditation from Medical Education Commission of Nepal.

Similarly, University Grants Commission (UGC) has launched the Quality Assurance and Accreditation (QAA) program as an important aspect to reform higher education in Nepal. The system ensures that the campus meets the certain predetermined minimal criteria or standards, not only at institutional level but also in its academic programs to offer better results to the society. Understanding its importance, Nepalgunj Nursing Campus has initiated the process of getting QAA from UGC and at present the campus is working on QAA process with submission of self-study report (SSR). With response by UGC the first PRT team visited to campus in Chaitra, 2081. The campus has incorporate the feedback given by first PRT visit of UGC. It is hoped that the campus will achieve QAA certificate within the specified period of time.

4. ACADEMIC OFFICIALS

All the faculties of each department lean to serve the excellent academic quality with integrity, compassion, and intellectual bravery. The campus appreciates the contributions of all its faculty members in making the campus a top nursing higher educational institution in country. 7. PROGRAM AND COURSES OFFERED

The Nepalgunj Nursing Campus has been running academic programs ranging from the Proficiency Certificate Level (PCL) in Nursing to bachelor-level programs. The bachelor programs include the Bachelor of Nursing Science (BNS) and the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.Sc. Nursing). The Post Basic Bachelor of Nursing (PBBN) program was initiated in 2011 AD with a duration of two years. The curriculum was revised in 2013 AD, extending it to three years with core courses in the first and second years and major courses in the third year, and was renamed the Bachelor of Nursing Science (BNS) program. Likewise, in 2021 AD, the four-year Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.Sc. Nursing) program was launched with an intake of five students in the first batch, followed by 30 students in the second, third, and fourth batches. Currently, 40 students are enrolled in the fifth batch. At present, the following courses are offered by the campus.

ENROLLMENT TREND ANALYSIS OF THE LAST THREE YEARS

STUDENT ENROLLMENT TREND

The number of students enrolled in various programs differs by seat matching by medical education commission. BNS program, number of students in 2079/80 and 2080/81 enrollment reduced than the previous year. In 2081/82 the number of BNS students enrolled was 26. Similarly, B.Sc. Nursing program which was started in the year 2078/79 with 5 numbers of students also shows increasing trend according to seat available that is 30 numbers of students in the years 2079/080, 2080/81, 40 in 2081/82.

The analysis of the pass rate trend over the last three years indicates that approximately half of the 10th batch students of the BNS program passed the first-year examination, while most of them successfully passed the second-year examination. Similarly, the majority of the 11th batch BNS students passed the second-year examination. The results of the 12th batch BNS students are still pending, and the 13th batch is currently pursuing the program.

The first batch of the B.Sc. Nursing program had a relatively unsatisfactory result, particularly in the first year; however, almost all students successfully passed the second-year examination. Likewise, about half of the second batch students of the B.Sc. Nursing program passed the second-year examination. The fourth batch of the B.Sc. Nursing program is currently in the first year of study.

10. PHYSICAL PROGRESS

10.1 RESOURCE CENTER (LIBRARY)

The library of Nepalgunj Nursing Campus is located within the campus premises and serves as a vital academic resource center for students and faculty members. It provides a conducive learning environment with a spacious, well-furnished reading room that supports both individual and group study. The library is equipped with high-speed internet facilities to facilitate access to online learning resources and research materials.

At present, the library houses a total of 9,045 textbooks, 232 reference books, 63 national journals, and 114 magazines. In addition to its print resources, the library has been steadily expanding its digital collection to enhance access to e-books, online journals, and other digital academic materials. Continuous efforts are being made to strengthen the library's infrastructure and digital services to meet the evolving academic and research needs of students and faculty members.

10.2 EDUCATIONAL AIDS

Nepalgunj Nursing Campus has been continuously updating its teaching-learning materials and pedagogical approaches in alignment with advancements in information technology and contemporary educational trends. The campus places high priority on integrating modern technologies to enhance the quality of education. Traditional blackboard and chalk methods have been replaced by whiteboards and markers to create a more interactive learning environment.

The campus has a total of six well-furnished classrooms, each with a seating capacity of more than forty students. Every classroom is equipped with a multimedia projector, whiteboard, ceiling fan, adequate lighting, proper ventilation, and comfortable furniture. At present, the campus possesses seven multimedia projectors, twenty-five computers, seven laptops, and six printers that are actively in use.

Furthermore, the campus maintains four well-equipped and well-furnished laboratories: the Fundamental Nursing Laboratory, Midwifery Laboratory, Basic Science Laboratory, and Community and Nutrition Laboratory. These facilities support practical learning and skill development among students.

To make teaching and learning more effective and practice-oriented, the campus has adopted modern educational technologies, including smart boards and innovative teaching materials, along with student-centered pedagogical methods. Teaching-learning activities include PowerPoint

presentations, group discussions, seminars, workshops, case study presentations, demonstrations, re-demonstrations, and report writing. Additionally, students are encouraged to engage in self-directed learning. Clinical skills are developed through practical exposure by posting students in various clinical areas in accordance with the curricular requirements.

10.3 PHYSICAL FACILITIES AND INFRASTRUCTURE

The Nepalgunj Nursing Campus of Tribhuvan University, Institute of Medicine (TU, IOM), is a leading institution in the Lumbini Province, dedicated to providing quality nursing education and fostering academic excellence. The campus occupies an area of 1 bigha, 16 kattha, and 14 dhur within its premises. It is supported by a team of highly qualified and dedicated faculty members, administrative personnel, and support staff who collectively contribute to a peaceful and conducive learning environment.

The campus is well-equipped with essential academic and infrastructural facilities, including skills laboratories, a computer lab, a library, and well-furnished classrooms. Transportation facilities such as a mini bus and a Tata Sumo Gold are available for students' convenience. In addition, hostel accommodations, generator backup, and free Wi-Fi access are provided to ensure a comfortable and supportive learning experience.

Altogether, the campus comprises ten buildings, including an administrative block housing various sections, faculty offices, and the library. There are also two academic buildings, two hostel blocks, and a skills laboratory building with separate rooms for nursing fundamentals, community health, midwifery, and basic science. The campus offers adequate clinical placement opportunities in specialized hospitals to enhance students' practical learning and professional exposure. Furthermore, staff residential facilities are available, including one building for the Campus Chief and two for academic and administrative staff. A canteen is also available on the premises to meet the dietary needs of students and staff.

11.QAA/EMIS

The goal of the Quality Assurance and Accreditation (QAA) system is to enhance the overall standard of higher education in Nepal. The QAA process ensures that higher education institutions meet a set of defined criteria at both the institutional and program levels to deliver quality academic outcomes and contribute effectively to societal development.

Nepalgunj Nursing Campus is currently in the process of attaining QAA certification issued by the University Grants Commission (UGC), Nepal. The campus qualified for the QAA process after receiving the Letter of Intent (LOI) acceptance from the UGC on March 14, 2022. Under the leadership of Campus Chief Ms. Tulsa Sunar, the campus has established key mechanisms for quality assurance, including the Internal Quality Assurance Committee (IQAC), Education Management and Information System (EMIS), and the Self-Assessment Team (SAT). It is anticipated that Nepalgunj Nursing Campus will successfully complete the QAA cycle within the next two years.

12. RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

Research is a vital component of nursing education, as it significantly influences both current and future professional practice. Over the past few years, Nepalgunj Nursing Campus has developed into a prominent research-oriented institution, actively involving both faculty and students in research activities. The campus is committed to supporting and promoting research initiatives, providing a conducive environment for academic inquiry.

Faculty members and students are encouraged to engage in a wide range of research opportunities. In accordance with the curricular requirements, students of the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.Sc. Nursing) and Bachelor of Nursing Science (BNS) programs are required to undertake at least one research project per academic year. The campus facilitates these research activities by providing guidance, resources, and supervision, enabling students to conduct research and prepare scholarly reports. Students also have the opportunity to collaborate with experienced faculty members in diverse research settings, enhancing their practical and analytical skills.

Furthermore, several faculty members have received research grants from institutions such as the TU IOM Mini Research Grant, the Nepal Health Research Council (NHRC), and the University Grants Commission (UGC). All faculty members of Nepalgunj Nursing Campus have published research articles in national and international journals, reflecting the campus's strong commitment to advancing nursing knowledge and evidence-based practice.

12.1 RESEARCH MANAGEMENT CELLS ACTIVITIES

The goal of the Campus Research Management Cell (RMC) is to advance and enhance the quality of multidisciplinary research activities. The RMC was established to facilitate research across various academic areas and to identify novel perspectives through the exploration and

validation of innovative ideas.

To promote and strengthen research activities, the RMC organized a five-day training program for faculty members on the topics of Research Methodology and Data Management from 2025/04/30 to 2025/05/03, with the support of the University Grants Commission and Nepalgunj Nursing Campus. Additionally, since June 2025, the RMC has introduced provisions for research grants for both faculty members and students to encourage scholarly inquiry and innovation. Looking ahead, the Research Management Cell plans to publish its own research journal to further disseminate academic and scientific contributions.

An exhibition was conducted including the topics like preparation of sarbottam pitho (lito), Nutritional pyramid, Diet for pregnant and breast feeding women.

13.7 SCHOOL HEALTH PROGRAM

Children as change agents been utilized by the health industry to streamline the society in a couple of occasions and several research articles do proclaim the strength of this approach. Keeping this view in mind the students of our institutes are being asked to visit the schools in the local community as a part of their field visits.
